new mysqli($host, $user, $pass)
$connect->errno
$connect->error
$result->fetch_array()
$result->fetch_assoc()
$result->fetch_row()
$result->fetch_object()
$connect->insert_id
$result->num_rows
$connect->query($sql)

$connect->select_db($dbname)
```

Note that some items in the object-oriented column do not have the parentheses () at the end of the statement. This means that those items are properties, not methods. Thus, they are used as variables, as in the following:

```
echo $connect->error;
```
